"El Relator Gran Premio" Two classic red grapes from Argentina cofermented in a true grand prize

COMPOSITION: 50 % Malbec - 50 % Tempranillo

VINTAGE: 2016

VINEYARDS:

Malbec grapes from San Carlos (La Consulta) and Tempranillo also from San Carlos (Pareditas)

HARVEST:

Early april, manual

ELABORATION:

It is a Blend that is made with 50% of each of its components (Malbec and Tempranillo). It has been aged for 9 months in barrels (only 10% of the time in new barrels). It works with a whole bunch. Cofermentation. 5000 bottles are produced per year.

TASTING NOTES:

Red wine with a reddish color with purplish sheen. Aromatically fruity with notes of cherries, plums and crisp strawberries intertwined with mineral traces of wet rocks. In the background it is earthy and balsamic. In the mouth it is intense, broad with linear freshness and firm tannins with a chalky texture.
